**Location:** Country Joe Racing Facility Lakeville, MN

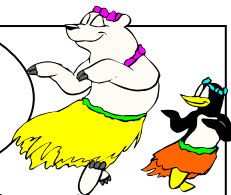
**Time:** Exact time TBD, (It's looking like mid afternoon)
