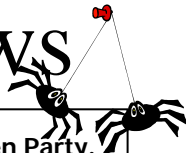


October Pack 119 News

Popcorn is almost done!

Here is a recap of the new Incentives this year.

The best one is for those who sell \$1000 they will increase their scout account percents to 21% instead of 17.5%.

The amount earned just from the increase is enough for a scout and adult to go to polar camp using extra account dollars.

And for those who sell \$1750 in product they will receive 23% instead of 17.5%.

Please refer the incentive sheet in your selling packet for a more detailed list of all the incentives for this year from council and the pack.

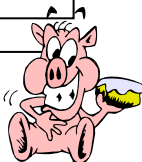
So the more you sell the faster you increase your scout account. You can use this money in your account for anything scout related. For example, camps, council events, cub scout sports events, any purchases at the scout shop and so on.

We have kept the Chuck E Cheese incentive and the level of \$750 has not changed. The boys who went last year had a great time. The Park at MOA incentive has been decreased to \$1500 to make this a more achievable incentive. All our Pack incentives can have other family members added to the fun for a small fee. If your scout earns these incentives you will be given the option to add other family members.

If we as a pack sold our goal of \$50,000, there will be a bunch of leaders who get a whip cream pie in their face.

The top 12 sellers will be revealed. They will get to throw the pies. We will also have the pack incentive sheet with the Chuck E Cheese Date, and the Park At MOA date.



Important Popcorn Dates

October 27th – Last Blitz Night We Leave from Diane's 5:45pm Sharp. Please make sure you are there on time. We are adding a fifth blitz night because there is enough product left at this point to sell and deliver at the blitz. If you would like to participate arrive at Diane's before 5:45pm. Please do not bring your scouts personal order forms or their personal product.

October 30th – Popcorn Sale Ends, Turn in your extra product, money and order forms 6:30pm-8:30pm Diane's Make sure your check out sheet is fully filled out, front and back. Note your scouts prize selection and if they would like a patch or pin. Have your money counted and separated into cash and checks. Make sure if you have taken soldier donations you have this amount separate on paper. Bring back any extra product with you and make sure your check in form is filled out with the product you still need. If these are items we have in stock your order will be filled immediately, if not they will be ordered for you and be in on Friday November 17th.

November 17th – Pick up any product we had to order. If you did not receive all your product at the end of the selling period you can pick your product up at Diane's so you can deliver your items. Pick up times TBA at a later date. The window of time depends on when the product is available for Diane to pick up from Council.

November 18th – Soldier Tin Send Off 9:30am @ Diane's We will meet at Diane's at 9:30am. The scouts will help stuff and package the soldier tins. We will then stack them for a pack photo. And if we able to get the mail truck to pick up this day, we will also load the truck. If not the truck will come on Monday and pick up our prepared packages. This is a great way for the scouts to see the follow through of all their hard work. This is also the time that a photo will be taken to use with our article in the papers and at council. We have been asked by a couple of different families and people with in the community to also send over a few supplies to the soldiers that they have provided to our pack. They will be paying for the shipping, not the pack. But the scouts will help in packaging these items and sending them overseas.



Drink Packets To Go Overseas

A few soldiers we talked to while selling popcorn thanked us for our efforts. They also said that the soldiers have to drink lots of water every day, and plain water gets old really fast. So they suggested that maybe we send some instant drink packs with the popcorn as a special drink treat.

So we as a pack are going to try and send some instant coffee packets and some lemonade to go packets overseas stuffed in the corners of the popcorn packages.

We are asking the families within our pack if you can help us out and pick up a package of instant drink packets for our soldiers the next time you head to the store. Our hopes are to send a couple individual packets over in each of our popcorn boxes.

Veterans Memorial and Parade

We have been given a really neat opportunity to participate in the commemoration of the new Veterans Memorial in Lakeville. The memorial is located at Aronson Park, 8250 202nd St. W.

Events for the day are as follows.

- 7-9am \$6 All you can eat breakfast at the VFW on Upper 208th St. If you wish to eat before the events start.
- 9:00am Assist in decorating around the memorial at Aronson Park. Meet at Aronson Park. Start here if you choose not to do breakfast.
- 9:45am- Brief instructions on the Pledge of Allegiance protocol to ensure dignity of delivery. Our boys will be helping lead the pledge with other scouts from the area.
- 10:30am-Parade begins. Our pack may participate in this parade. We need a volunteer to help coordinate the pack banners and flags.
- 11:45am-All scouts in attendance to be on site and assembled for the pledge/ parade scouts will march/walk to the park with the parade.
- 12-1:15pm Ceremony / Pledge / etc.
Scouts must be in proper uniform. So have your scout wear long underwear and a few layers under their uniforms. They will probably have to take off their jackets for a little bit.
- 1:15-6pm Lunch/Dinner will be offered at the VFW on Upper 208th St. W., where military vehicles and memorabilia will be on display. Proceeds from the day's events will go towards the memorial fund.

The ceremony will include bands, dignitaries, guest speakers, and a ceremonial fly over.
