Important Popcorn Dates



September 29th – Pick up your popcorn product so you can deliver the product when you make the sale. See Diane to make your appointment to pick up your product. Remember for those of you who sold last year, your scout will receive the dollar amount in product that he sold last year, but it will not be the exact products he sold. If your scout didn't sell over \$1000 he will not be receiving any large 3-way tins with his show and sell pick up. Do still sell these items and contact Diane for pick up after they are sold. The pack has a limited inventory of these items and can't give every scout a large inventory.

September 30th – Popcorn Sale Begins. Please don't let your scout take orders or sell before this date. If you are in need of more product or order forms at any time, contact Diane and she will be happy to get you some more. You may also make copies of your order forms to sell from but we have plenty of new forms to use just ask for them. Your scout will be given order forms upon check out the night before, the more product he is given the more forms he will take home. Please have the customers make their checks payable to Pack 119.

October 17th – Blitz Night #1 5:45pm-7:30pm Diane's Show up at Diane's home between 5:30 and 5:45. We will go as a group out selling in the neighborhoods, leaving at 5:45pm sharp. Have your scout wear their Class A uniforms but dress for the weather. Be prepared to have to possibly carry product in your vehicles. Leave your scouts personal product and order forms at home you will be given separate forms and product. You will be notified of the credit your scout will receive for the Blitz night with in a few days of the event. Parents must attend.

October 18th – Midway deposit Night 6:30pm-8:30pm Diane's If your scout has been out selling and you have a pile of checks and cash and would like to turn in a deposit so you are not holding onto this money here is your chance to do so. You may also come turn in money and check out more products if you need some. Or if you are done selling and would like to turn in your entire selling packet and left over product you may do so as well.

October 19th – Blitz Night #2 5:45pm-7:30pm Diane's Read the information from Blitz Night #1

October 21st – 22nd – Econo Foods/Pellicci Hardware Booths See Diane for the sign up sheets. You may sign your scout up for a one-hour time slot, either on Sat or Sun. You will need to be present with your scout during their time and may not just drop them off. Scouts will need to be in their Class A uniforms and we recommend parents to be either in their leader uniforms if you have one or in a pack tee shirt. Show up just inside the doors at Econo Foods a few minutes before your time and you will directed to either stay at Econo or go to Pellicci Booth for the hour. You will be notified of the credit your scout will receive for helping the beginning of the next week.

October 23rd – Blitz Night #3 5:45pm-7:30pm Nikki's Please note the location change. We will be starting from Nikki's this night only. 4969 193rd Street. See description under Blitz night #1 for other details.

October 25th – Blitz Night #4 5:45pm-7:30pm Diane's This is our last Blitz night and it has the possibility to be cancelled if the pack has run out of inventory. If you plan on attending a Blitz night try to make an earlier one. Last year we were able to obtain extra product from council to hold this blitz, it may be possible again if we are short. Meet at Diane's again and note the other details in Blitz night #1.

October 30th – Popcorn Sale Ends, Turn in your extra product, money and order forms 6:30pm-8:30pm Diane's Make sure your check out sheet is fully filled out, front and back. Note your scouts prize selection and if they would like a patch or pin. Have your money counted and separated into cash and checks. Make sure if you have taken soldier donations you have this amount separate on paper. Bring back any extra product with you and make sure your check in form is filled out with the product you still need. If these are items we have in stock your order will be filled immediately, if not they will be ordered for you and be in on Friday November 17th.

We had a great turn out for the Parent Popcorn Meeting. If you were unable to make this meeting make sure you see Diane Wiggert before you leave tonight for your selling packet. Order forms will be given out when you pick up your product on Sept 29th.

Make note of our new Incentives this year.

The best one is for those who sell \$1000 they will increase their scout account percents to 21% instead of 17.5%.

The amount earned just from the increase is enough for a scout and adult to go to polar camp using extra account dollars.

And for those who sell \$1750 in product they will receive 23% instead of 17.5%.

Please refer the incentive sheet in your selling packet for a more detailed list of all the incentives for this year from council and the pack.

So the more you sell the faster you increase your scout account. You can use this money in your account for anything scout related. For example, camps, council events, cub scout sports events, any purchases at the scout shop and so on.

We have kept the Chuck E Cheese incentive and the level of \$750 has not changed. The boys who went last year had a great time. The Park at MOA incentive has been decreased to \$1500 to make this a more achievable incentive. All our Pack incentives can have other family members added to the fun for a small fee. If your scout earns these incentives you will be given the option to add other family members.



Fall Festival Day Camp

For those of you who are new Tigers or just new to our Pack and have never been to camp this is a great way to experience what camp is like. You will get to go from station to station shooting BB Guns, participating in Archery, playing scout games and making some crafts. There will also be a hayride tour of the camp. Family and siblings over the age of 2 are also invited to participate. All children must pay the registration fee. Adults are free. Siblings who are cub scout age or older can pay and participate in the scout structured activities.
